



Dr. Dong Yu is the Head of Antigen Identification and Molecular Biology, Preclinical R&D US at GSK Vaccines. He received the PhD from University of Connecticut Health Center, and was a faculty member at Washington University and the Head of Microbial Molecular Biology at Novartis Vaccines before joining GSK Vaccines in 2015. Dr. Yu authored over 40 publications in the areas of virology, infectious diseases, and vaccines, and a recipient of several prestigious awards, including the Investigator in the Pathogenesis of Infectious Disease Award from Burroughs Wellcome, the Wyeth Young Investigator Award in Vaccine Development from IDSA, and the Howard Temin Award from NIH.
