



Keiji Itaka, M.D., Ph.D. is a professor of Dpt. Biofunction Research, Institute of Biomaterial and Bioengineering, Tokyo Medical and Dental University (TMDU). He is an orthopaedic surgeon and doing researches of DDS, gene therapy, biomaterials, and regenerative medicine. He has been working on mRNA for several years, and published excellent papers of mRNA-based therapeutics, some of which were awarded as Best Abstract Award in this mRNA Health Conference.
